At the seafarers' Centre, we provide the following services:

- Chapel and prayer area (Religious service onboard the ship available upon request. Please allow sufficient time for us to arrange with a Clergy the schedule for religious service.)
- Convenience and Souvenir shop (The following are sold and can be delivered to the ship on request.)—
 - ✓ Magnets and key chains (Canada and MtS Halifax) -- \$3.00
 - ✓ Mugs (Canada and MtS) -- \$3.00 - \$5.00 respectively
 - ✓ Jackets and t-shirts (Canada and MtS) – prices vary
 - ✓ Chocolate bars and chips -- \$1.50
 - ✓ Pop and fruit juice -- \$1.50
 - ✓ Domestic and imported beer is served inside the Centre after 1000 local time.
- Free Wifi within the building (Accessible inside and surrounding areas outside the building. Outside, there is a bus shelter with heater, and this is available 24 hours / 7 days a week.)
- Free use of pool table and dartboard
- Lounging areas inside the building and at the yard
- Free Room (Donated shirts and pants, sweaters and jackets, shoes, blankets, suitcases, caps, puzzles, and other items. Ask about other items - we may be able to find them for you.
- Transport service (depending on availability of Mission van) to the Mission, shopping centres, medical and dental, including vaccination clinics, Maritime Museum (free entrance), and other areas of interest. Seafarers may be picked up from and brought back to ship on an arranged schedule.
- BICYCLES – to borrow for sightseeing!
- We have guitars for sale – ask us about them!
- We have a gently used piano – come and play for us!
